

We are focusing a lot on maps and charts. We hope to have several electronic formats of the study Bible available by the end of the year. We have begun testing setup for the electronic study Bible.

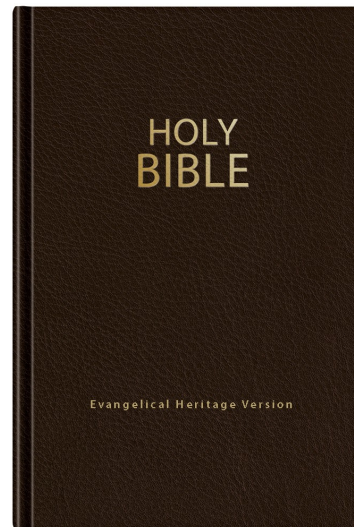
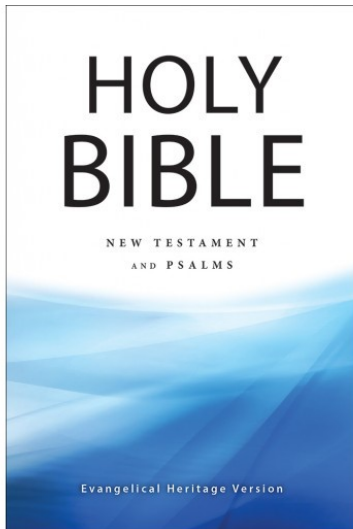
