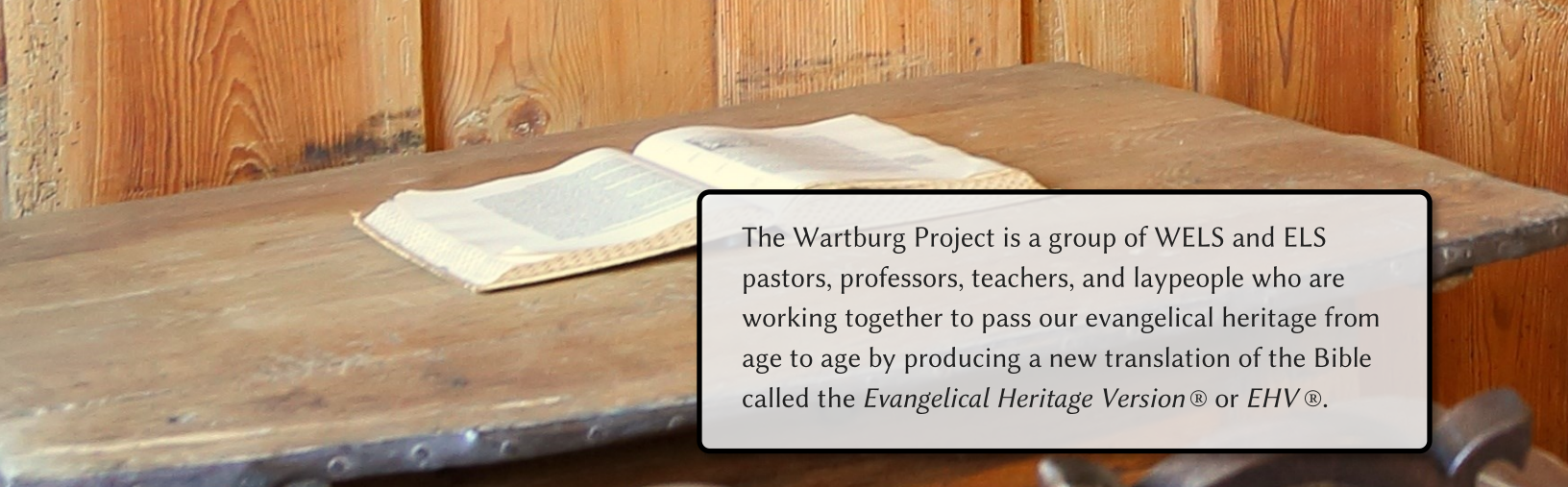

THE MANGER

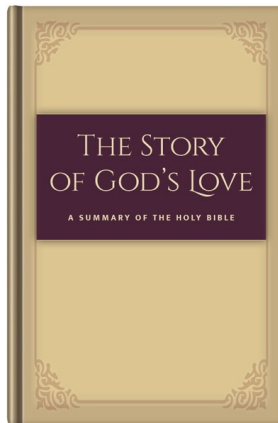
A *manger* is a feeding trough for animals. They usually were made of clay or stone, not wood. The manger in the picture is the trough in the right corner of the courtyard.

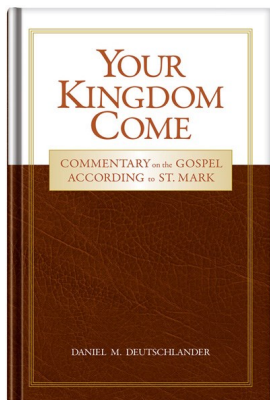

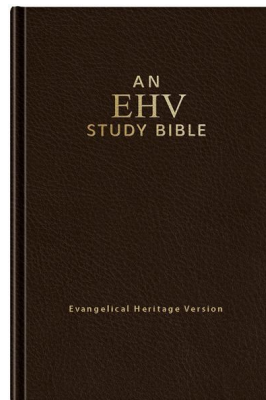
