Books for which are assigned and initial drafts are expected to be in progress or completed in 2014: Ruth, Ezra, Ecclesiastes, Ezekiel, Daniel, Amos, Jonah, Micah, 1 Corinthians, Colossians, James, 1 and 2 Peter, Jude, Revelation, and others.
