If you are a glutton for punishment, you may also read the very technical note on the dating of the Kings and the fall of Jerusalem from the EHV introduction to Ezekiel.

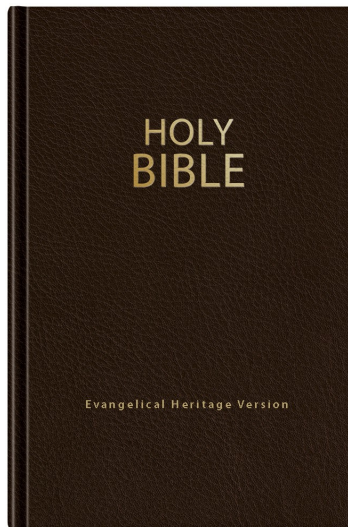
