Grass withers, flowers fade, but the Word of our God endures forever. Translators come, translations go, but the Word of our God endures forever.


Progress Reports

For most of this year, our monthly reports will be pretty much the same:

- 1. We have drafts for the study Bible notes for the entire Old Testament, and all of these drafts are out for comments from reviewers. We expect to allow the rest of this year for this process. Preliminary note gathering is well under way for the New Testament. This progress is updated each month in the "Progress Chart for the EHV Study Bible" (Page 3 of this issue).
- 2. We are continuing work on maps and supplemental materials.
- 3. We have received additional inquiries about licenses to use EHV in products.

By summer we hope to re-organize our list of FAQ's and our online library to make it more user-friendly.


