First Sunday in Advent

Second Sunday in Advent

Alleluia. Prepare the way of the Lord! Make his paths straight. And everyone will see the salvation of God. Alleluia. (Luke 3:4, 6, EHV)

Third Sunday in Advent

Alleluia. Look, I am sending my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way before you. Alleluia. (Matthew 11:10, EHV)

Fourth Sunday in Advent

Alleluia. “Look, the virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son. And they will name him Immanuel,” which means, “God with us.” Alleluia. (Matthew 1:23, EHV)

The Nativity of Our Lord—Christmas Eve

The Nativity of Our Lord—Christmas Day

Fourth Sunday after the Epiphany

Alleluia. The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he anointed me to preach good news. Alleluia. (Luke 4:18a, EHV)

Fifth Sunday after the Epiphany

Alleluia. Jesus said, "I am the Light of the World. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." Alleluia. (John 8:12, EHV)

Sixth Sunday after the Epiphany

Alleluia. "Lord, to whom will we go? You have the words of eternal life." Alleluia. (John 6:68 EHV)

Seventh Sunday after the Epiphany

Alleluia. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. Alleluia. (Luke 6:36, EHV)

Eighth Sunday after the Epiphany

Alleluia. By the mercies of the LORD we are not consumed, for his compassions do not fail. Alleluia. (Lamentations 3:22, EHV)

Last Sunday after the Epiphany—The Transfiguration of Our Lord

Ash Wednesday

Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in mercy. (Joel 2:13, EHV)

First Sunday in Lent

"It is written, 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'" (Matthew 4:10b, EHV)

Second Sunday in Lent

Jesus humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death—even death on a cross. (Philippians 2:8b, EHV)

Third Sunday in Lent

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, ¹⁵so that everyone who believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:14,15, EHV)

Fourth Sunday in Lent

For God so loved the world that he gave his only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish, but have eternal life. (John 3:16, EHV)

Fifth Sunday in Lent

The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. (Mark 10:45, EHV)

Sixth Sunday in Lent—Palm Sunday

The time has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. (John 12:23, EHV)

Maundy Thursday

As often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. (1 Corinthians 11:26, EHV)

Good Friday

Surely he was taking up our weaknesses, and he was carrying our sufferings, but we thought he was stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. (Isaiah 53:4, EHV)

The Resurrection of Our Lord—Easter Dawn

P16 Alleluia. Rejoice in the Lord always! I will say it again: rejoice! Alleluia. (Philippians 4:4, EHV)

P17 Alleluia. Whatever was written in the past was written for our instruction, so that, through patient endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures, we would have hope. Alleluia. (Romans 15:4, EHV)

P18 Alleluia. My grace is sufficient for you, because my power is made perfect in weakness. Alleluia. (2 Corinthians 12:9a, EHV)

P19 Alleluia. At the name of Jesus every knee will bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Alleluia. (Philippians 2:10,11, EHV)

P20 Alleluia. I will declare your name to my brothers. Within the congregation I will sing your praise. Alleluia. (Hebrews 2:12, EHV)

P21 Alleluia. This is the LORD! We waited for him; let us be glad and rejoice in his salvation!" Alleluia. (Isaiah 25:9b, EHV)
