

Jesus' Miracles

Most of the many charts of Jesus' miracles list about 37 miracles. These 37 miracles are described in the four Gospels. Jesus performed many other miracles which are mentioned but not described in the Gospels. These other miracles are simply summarized in statements such as "Jesus healed many people at that time."

Because the Gospels are not always arranged chronologically, it is not possible to list all the miracles in order. That has not prevented people from trying. The following list reflects some of the opinions about the order of the miracles. Some of these arrangements are debatable. It appears that Matthew's arrangement of the miracles is less chronological than Luke's and Mark's, but none of the Synoptic Gospels is strictly chronological. # marks some of the miracles for which there is a chronological question.

Many of these miracles were performed during Jesus' ministry in Galilee. Others were performed in Jerusalem. Luke reports a number of miracles not recorded in any other Gospel because he is the only evangelist who reports extensively on Jesus' ministry in Perea, east of the Jordan. The red/purple color marks miracles that appear in only one Gospel.
